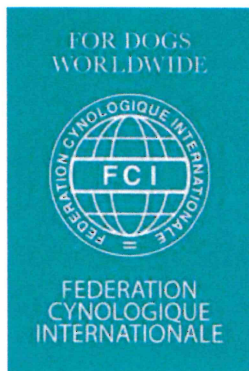

Mrs President

As you are aware the FCI General Assembly met on November 6-7, 2017 in Leipzig. A motion on the agenda was the points proposed by two Full Members, Latvia and Moldova (see attached).

Both motions were discussed at the same time.

Following a long debate, it was agreed to implement the attached agreement, signed in 2011 on the occasion of the FCI General Assembly held in Paris. Point 3 of the agreement was particularly discussed.

As a consequence, following a vote by the General Assembly, it was resolved to remove the Hong-Kong Kennel Club from the list of the FCI full members **from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. From that date onwards, the only and sole representative of The People's Republic of China within the FCI will be the China Kennel Union.**

With a view to efficiently protect the interests of the breeders operating under the Hong-Kong Kennel Club, the General Assembly has agreed to grant a transition period, ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018, so that all activities related to your breeders (pedigrees, kennel names, championship titles, etc) will be properly transferred to China Kennel Union.

In this context, the FCI General Assembly gave a mandate to the China Kennel Union to start negotiating with the Hong-Kong Kennel Club to ensure a smooth transition and administration of all the files related to Hong-Kong Kennel Club breeders/members.

We thank you for your cooperation and are convinced that both organisations will do their utmost, in an efficient, wise and professional way, to ensure that the work done by the members of Hong-Kong Kennel Club be preserved.
